

*Is this Frequency in use? Is this Frequency in use?*

*Good (**Morning; Afternoon; Evening**)!*

*This is the Overlook Mountain Weather Net.*

*This is (**CALLSIGN phonetically**).*

*My name is (**NAME**) and I'm located in (**TOWN, STATE**) and I will be operating as today's Weather Net Control.*

*The purpose of this Net is to gather weather observations from around the greater Mid-Hudson Region during major weather events.*

*This Weather Net meets on a prescribed schedule **ONLY WHEN ACTIVATED** by a major weather event.*

*Our repeater frequency is 146.805 MHz with a Minus 600 kHz offset and PL tone of 103.5 Hz.*

*Today's session is the (**DATE & TIME**) weather check-in.*

*Again, this is station, (**CALLSIGN**). I will now stand by for check-ins. Please state you **CALLSIGN, FIRST NAME** and **QTH**. Thank you!*

**After the roster is noted, the following statement should be read:**

*Please report the following information in order using our format:*

- 1. Current Conditions*
- 2. Temperature in degrees Fahrenheit (rising or falling)*
- 3. Barometric Pressure in inches (rising or falling)*
- 4. Wind Speed and Direction*
- 5. Current Snow Depth*
- 6. Current Road Conditions if known*

**Here is an example of a statement to read at the close of the net:**

*This has been the (**DATE & TIME**) OMARC Weather Net.*

*I want to thank all member stations who checked in this (**Morning; Afternoon, Evening**) for providing this public service.*

*The net is now closed and the frequency returned to general amateur use. This is (**CALLSIGN**) clear. 73.*
